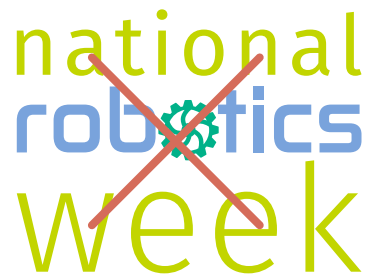

Typography

The official font of National Robotics Week is Fira Sans. This font is part of the logo, so it makes sense to continue using it.

Headers are usually in Fira Sans Bold, and body copy is in Fira Sans Regular or Fira Sans Light — But all versions of Fira Sans can be used with discretion.

This body copy uses Fira Sans Regular.
